We have the following safety protocols in place:

Visits to the Centre by Appointment ONLY

We will encourage all visitors and clients to the Centre to call ahead and book an appointment to help control the number of people in the Centre at any given time.

Daily Pre-Screening of all Personnel Entering Centre

All staff, volunteers, clients and approved guests are screened for their recent contacts and physical symptoms. Everyone is required to sanitize their hands upon entering the premises.

Personal Protective Equipment for all Staff, Volunteers and Clients

Although not mandatory, masks and gloves will be made available for anyone wanting to wear them.

Social Distancing While Waiting and Moving Throughout the Centre

Please be respectful to physically distance by two metres.

Above-Standard Protocols for Sanitation of Hands, and Surfaces

1. Hand sanitizers at all points of entry and sitting areas.
2. All surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized after every client visit.
3. Washroom will be cleaned and sanitized after each use.
4. We encourage you to remember the importance of basic measures you can take to help prevent the spread of COVID-19, including: wash your hands regularly, avoid touching your face, sneeze/cough into your arm, and stay home if you are ill.
